

Join the Event Crew and be the heartbeat of the FS France !


The Event Crew drives **the execution of the entire event**, without them, nothing could run smoothly or safely.

We have four types of scrutineers, each specializing in a critical area: **mechanical, electrical, hydrogen, and autonomous** systems. From structural integrity to high-voltage safety, hydrogen protocols, and autonomous system checks, nothing escapes their attention.

Think of them as the responsible guardians of the paddock, like a **careful parent** who makes sure everything is in order before anyone leaves the garage. **Strict? Maybe.** But every check, every note, every inspection is about keeping everyone safe and upholding the highest standards, as they are the guardians of FS excellence.

The Dynamic Crew is the heartbeat of every track session, the team that makes all the action happen safely, smoothly, and on time.

They take charge of installing and supervising the 4 dynamic events : **Acceleration, Skidpad, Autocross, and Endurance.**

On the track, **they supervise every single run**, move the flags, communicate instantly with teams and other volunteers, and react immediately to any unexpected situation.

Think of them **as lifeguards in high-octane action**, eyes everywhere, always alert, ready to jump into action at a moment's notice. They balance speed and safety perfectly, making sure drivers can push their cars to the limit without compromising anyone's well-being.

Fast and proactive, the Dynamic Crew keeps the track alive, organized, and, above all, safe.
